ACTIVITIES/TEAM B LEAD

Objective: To serve the women who come to participate in Women's Camp out of a love of Christ and a spirit of willingness!

Qualifications:

Must be willing and able to meet the physical demands of setting up camp – setting up tents, lifting, climbing, walking around camp.

Have a spirit that is willing and excited to serve in whatever way is needed according to the following description.

Have an approachable and friendly personality for the women coming from different walks of life who may need guidance or assistance.

Be flexible to deal with both planned and unexpected needs as they arise – seek out and assist others throughout the weekend.

Description:

Before camp:

Plan Friday night and Saturday free time activities.

Effectively communicate needs with other committee members.

At camp:

Fully run activities over the weekend including set-up. Emcee if needed or find someone to emcee, tear down, etc.

Create activities sign-up sheets to put at Registration tent.

Lead the members of Team Barnabas in the following areas:

Facilitate the setting up of the glamping site on the Thursday before camp begins (set up tents, inflate air mattresses, set up lights, arrange tents into church pods, etc.).

Send specified members of Team B to assist with other facility set-up (dining hall, forum, registration, etc.).

Assign Team B members to areas as needs arise (registration, activities set-up and emcee).

Set up all activities – set up props and materials, build brackets for tournaments, etc.

Emcee activities as needed.

Run one of two taxi shifts over the course of the weekend.

Tear down glamping site and any other areas set-up prior to event. This must be completed Sunday before camp closes.

CRAFTS

Objective: The purpose of crafts is to create an environment where women can do crafts at Women's Camp while growing in relationship and building community with each other.

Crafts is located at Meadow Ridge and takes place during free time on Friday and Saturday.

Description:

Before camp:

Choose multiple crafts (three) for the women to choose from. Try to find crafts that are current and would appeal to a wide variety of women. It is best to pick different kinds of crafts (like something that is more of a home decor item, something that a woman could wear, something that is useful, etc). Women really enjoy learning new craft methods (like felting, stain glass, etc).

Determining what supplies will need to be purchased, researching the cost for the supplies and requesting a check for funds to purchase anything that will be needed.

Check inventory from past years before purchasing craft supplies.

Determining what the materials fee will be for campers to do each craft and communicating this to the committee.

Purchasing all craft supplies once the check is received.

Preparing all crafts before camp, this includes making multiple samples of each craft.

Consider making tutorials of how to do each craft. You can hand these out to the crafters.

Make signage for craft area (Price menu, where materials are located, etc).

Communicating and coordinating with a guest crafter if you choose to have one.

At camp

Decorating and setting up craft area.

Facilitating crafts during camp, this includes taking money, instructing women on how to do each craft, helping in any way that is needed and being relational.

Inventory supplies left over before storing away for the next year.

Breakdown of craft area after camp.

TAXI LEAD

Objective: To serve those ladies who need a little help maneuvering around camp.

Description:

Before Camp:

Understand the camp layout and guidelines of driving on camp property.
Provide your own van/car and proof of insurance. You will be refunded for gas.

At Camp:

Be friendly, safe, and efficient at getting people from point A to point B.
Making the ladies feel loved and encouraged.
Being available major times throughout the event.
Follow the guidelines of driving at camp. (IE: speed limit, parking, etc).
