

Perspective Questions

THE GOSPEL QUESTION:	What is the promise of this decision/candidate/policy? Does it reflect the gospel or a false gospel?
ENDS AND MEANS QUESTION:	Does the means as well as the end honor Jesus?
THE TIME AND SPACE QUESTION:	If I were in another time or another place would I see this differently?
THE TOOLS QUESTION:	Am I depending on the tools of the Spirit or the tools of the world? (2 Corinthian 10:3-6).
THE SERVICE QUESTION:	Does politics serve our life together as a church or does the church serve politics? (1 Timothy 2:1-6)
THE SELF-AWARENESS QUESTION:	What am I neglecting that the Bible demands? What do I believe that I can't find in the Bible?
THE DEBATE QUESTION:	Can I state the position I disagree with accuracy and fairness?
THE FEAR QUESTION:	Is this position based on fear?
THE SUB-QUESTION:	Are my actions submissive? Is my message subversive?
THE PARTISAN QUESTION:	Does this candidate or policy map perfectly onto my faith?
THE SOURCE QUESTION:	Can I tell whether the source of my perspective is truly Christian, American, or Partisan?
THE COMPLICATION QUESTION:	Can I acknowledge some level of complication or nuance? Where does the nuance lie? Is my take overly simplistic?
